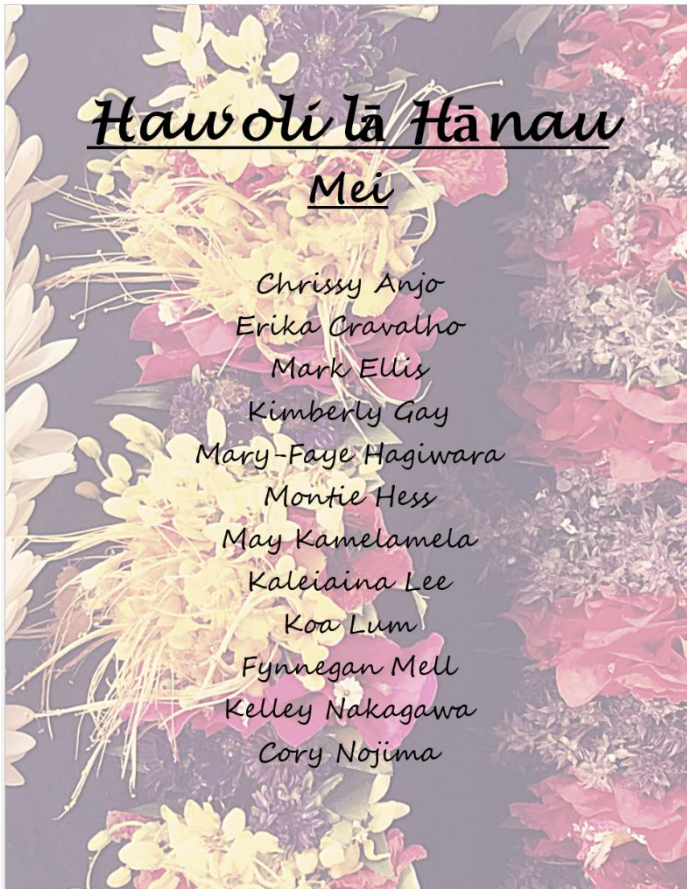


## PHHCC SCHOLARSHIPS
